



The Electrical Association of Philadelphia 2018 Residential Fall Rebate Program Requirements HEAT PUMP and CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING

Rebate Eligibility Requirements and Rebate Amounts

Rebates will be offered on full heat pump systems only (outdoor unit fan-bearing unit, and coil – manufacturer/distributor approved matches.) Add-on coils only are not eligible for a rebate. **NOTE: PECO Smart Home Rebates can be combined with this EAP rebate. No other rebates may be combined with EAP rebates.**

NOTE: MANUFACTURERS/DISTRIBUTORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO LIMIT REBATES WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN PRODUCT LINES. ANY SUCH RESERVATIONS MUST BE COMMUNICATED TO PARTICIPATING CONTRACTORS AT THE **BEGINNING** OF THE PROGRAM. CONTRACTORS, IN TURN, SHOULD VERIFY EQUIPMENT COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANUFACTURER/DISTRIBUTORS **BEFORE** PROMISING A REBATE TO A CUSTOMER.

Residential High Efficiency Equipment (Manufacturer/Distributor Approved Matches)

Heat Pump System:

- \$600 on a 16.0 to 17.99 SEER, 8.5 HSPF, 12.5 EER (or higher)
- \$700 on a 18.0 to 19.99 SEER, 8.5 HSPF, 12.5 EER (or higher)
- \$1,000 on a 20.0 or higher SEER, 8.5 HSPF, 12.5 EER (or higher)
- \$800 on an 18 EER geothermal heat pump system (or higher)

Additional \$100 on a dual fuel heat pump (hybrid): Heat Pump Efficiency must meet \$600 level Rebate (see above) - this is NOT a separate rebate, just an additional amount

Central Air Conditioning System:

- \$500 on a 16.0 to 17.99 SEER, 12.5 EER (or higher)
- \$700 on a 18.0 to 19.99 SEER, 12.5 EER (or higher)
- \$1,000 on a 20.0 or higher SEER, 12.5 EER (or higher)

Manufacturer/Distributor/Contractor Eligibility Requirements (one fee for both programs)

- All manufacturers/distributors and contractors must have paid their dues in full for 2018.
- Equipment for project quotes and/or new construction quotes is excluded from this offer. This offer is not valid in combination with other rebates.
- **NOTE:** Equipment purchased from Home Improvement or other Retail Stores is not eligible.

Rebate Payment Information

- Eligible consumers receive the rebate through a deduction for the full rebate amount **on the customer's invoice.**
- The Contractor and the Manufacturer or Distributor equally share the cost of the rebate; 50% Contractor and 50% Manufacturer or Distributor. Following installation, the Contractor must file a claim with The EAP to receive its remaining 50% of the rebate amount.
- Manufacturers/Distributors must reimburse Contractors **within 15 days of receiving claim forms.**
- Contracts may not be signed before **Wednesday, August 8, 2018.**
- Contracts must be signed by **Wednesday, November 14, 2018.**
- Systems must be installed by **Wednesday, December 5, 2018.**
- Contractors must file claims, including the completed claim form, an original invoice, and AHRI rating sheet, on or before **Wednesday, December 12, 2018.**
- Please scan and email or mail claim forms; no faxes, please.
